

DreamBox Getting Started Checklist

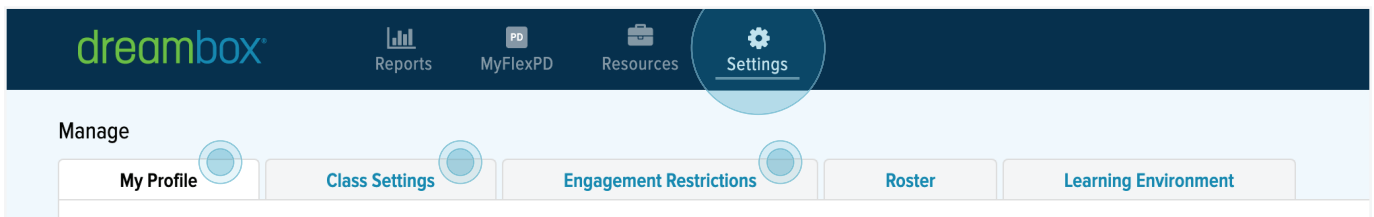
Welcome! We want to help get the school year off to a great start. Please utilize this checklist to help you and your students get started with DreamBox.

→ **Step 1:** Log into your Dashboard



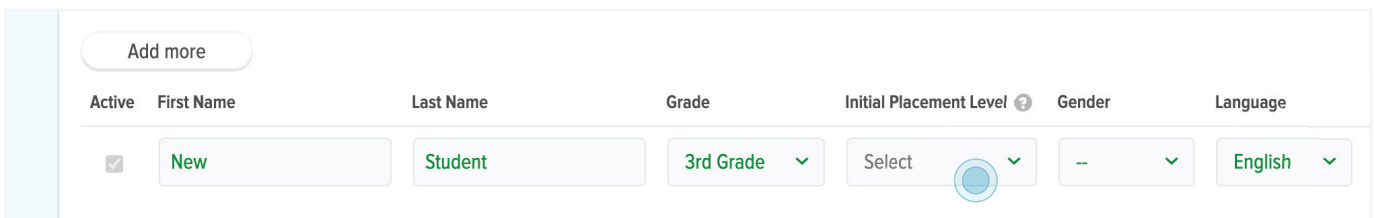
Congratulations! Thanks for following the steps in your welcome email. Step one complete. Continue to visit your Dashboard frequently.

→ **Step 2:** Customize Your Insights Dashboard

→ **Step 3:** Review Roster and Initial Placement



Under your **Settings** tab. Check your Classroom Roster(s) to review for accuracy. Make any **Initial Placement** adjustments prior to students accessing DreamBox. Once students start to play, the program will automatically adapt and differentiate in real-time to each student's right level of readiness. → **Step 4:** DreamBox and Assessment



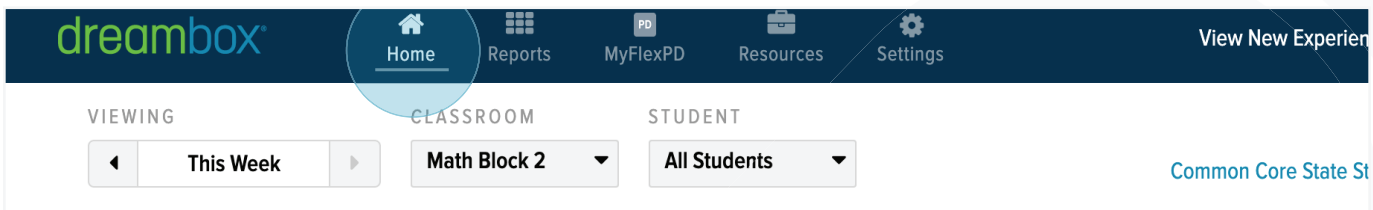
